Lawyers for Non-Profits:

There are two primary different options non-profits are able to pursue in dealing with tax related issues. A non-profit has the option of becoming either a 501 (c)(3) or obtaining a fiscal sponsorship. As a 501(c)(3) the non-profit is individually granted recognition as tax-exempt by the IRS, whereas a non-profit who chooses to engage in a fiscal sponsorship agrees to protection and filing rights under another organization's pre-existing 501(c)(3) status, as an umbrella arrangement. A lawyer specializing in non-profit law and issues will be able to advise and ultimately file for both types of IRS recognition.
